Announcement of Board Member Candidates

TOKYO, February 28, 2023 - Monex Group, Inc. ("the Company") hereby announces the Nominating Committee of the Company has decided to propose the appointment of the following candidates to the Board of Directors at the 19th Annual General Meeting of Shareholders scheduled to be held in June 2023.

The Board of Directors and Nominating Committee have conducted a comprehensive assessment on the current board structure over several times. With significant changes in our operating environment and the increasing difficulty of management decision making, the Company felt it may be beneficial to increase the ratio of outside directors while avoiding a drastic replacement of current directors who are familiar with our operations. Furthermore, the Company assessed the current directors by discussing such factors as how often and to what degree the current directors attended and actively participated in board meetings and their respective committee meetings. The Company also discussed that considering the skill matrix of current directors, it was necessary to appoint new directors who have management and innovation insight, technology expertise, and global experience.

As a result, the Company's Nominating Committee determined that it would be appropriate to increase the number of outside directors by one to seven while maintaining the current four inside directors, bringing the total to 11. Hence, the Company's Nominating Committee has resolved to submit a board member candidate election proposal to reappoint 10 current directors and appoint one new director at the 19th Annual General Meeting of Shareholders scheduled to be held in June 2023.
